

RACE TO THE TOP SWEEPSTAKES - OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR DONATION NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

A PURCHASE OR DONATION WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

BEGINS AT 9:00 AM EASTERN TIME ("ET") ON JANUARY 2, 2020 & ENDS AT 11:59 PM ET ON MAY 6, 2020 (THE "SWEEPSTAKES ENTRY PERIOD").

ELIGIBILITY: Open to legal residents of the 50 U. S. including Washington, DC & Canada (EXCLUDING the Province of Quebec), 18 years of age or older at time of entry. For each valid Alternate Entry received, you will receive the maximum ten (10) entries per person per day allowed. Alternate Entries must be postmarked between January 2, 2020 & May 6, 2020 & received by May 13, 2020 to be eligible.

LIMIT: Regardless of method of entry, there is a limit of ten (10) entries per person per day and an overall TOTAL limit of 50 entries for the entire sweepstakes per person.
